April has been a busy month for us on the project, various works have been continued and new operations carried out.

Groundworks around the project are continuing with a big push on external ground make-ups in readiness for the tarmac roads. Drainage and services are well underway across the scheme and soft landscaping has been commenced in line with the planting season.

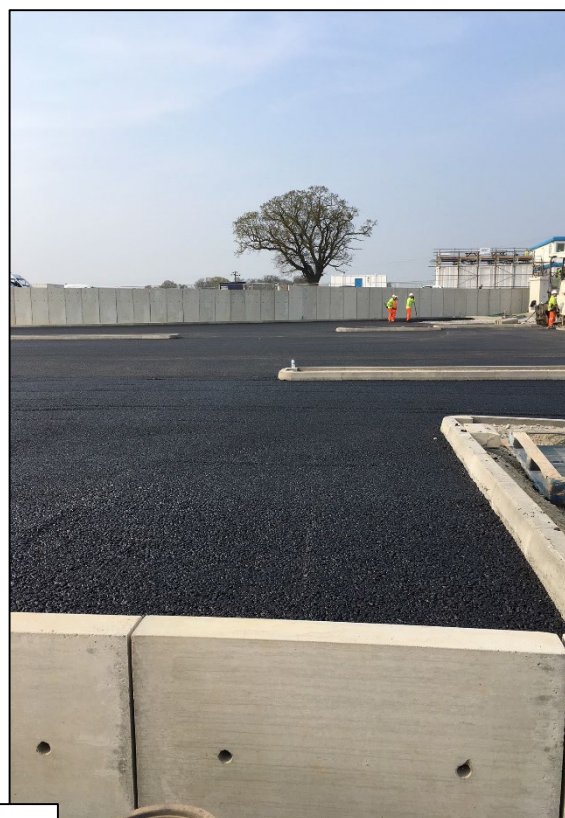
The buildings are progressing nicely now that all cladding is complete. This has meant the internal works have been able to be progressed which include the plastering, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> fix mechanical & electrical works, painting and preparations for both ceiling installation and floor coverings.

The concrete slab to the waste transfer station is now complete and the fire suppression system is being installed.

Hopefully the S278 works (road widening to Fornham Road) aren't causing too much delay to your journeys around the area. We are happy to confirm we are currently on target for completion of these works which will show the road complete around 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2019.

We are planning on holding our next coffee morning on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2019 @10.00am. It's another opportunity for you to receive an update on the project and take a peak from our viewing platform. We may even have a opportunity to walk out on site!!
